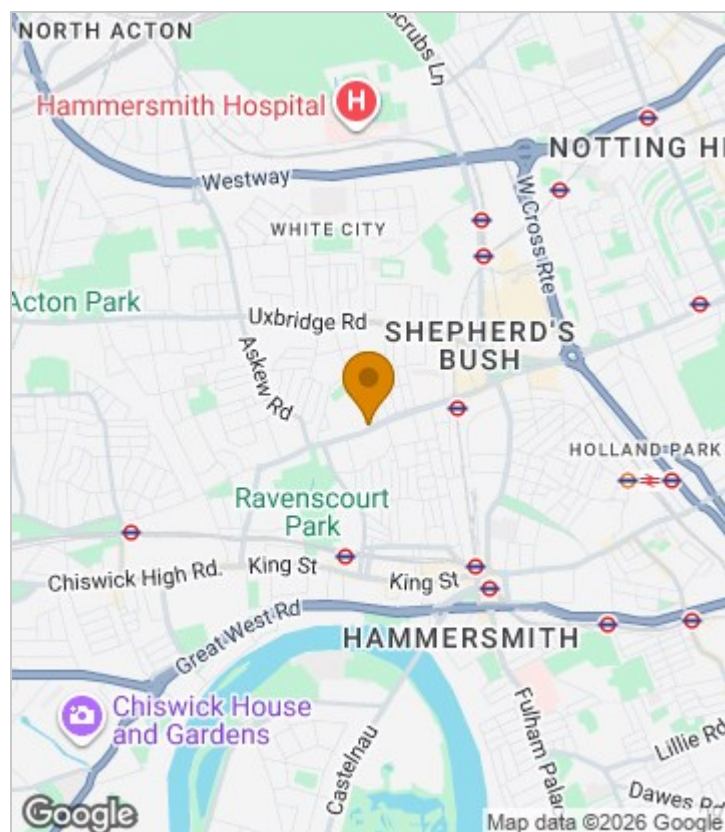

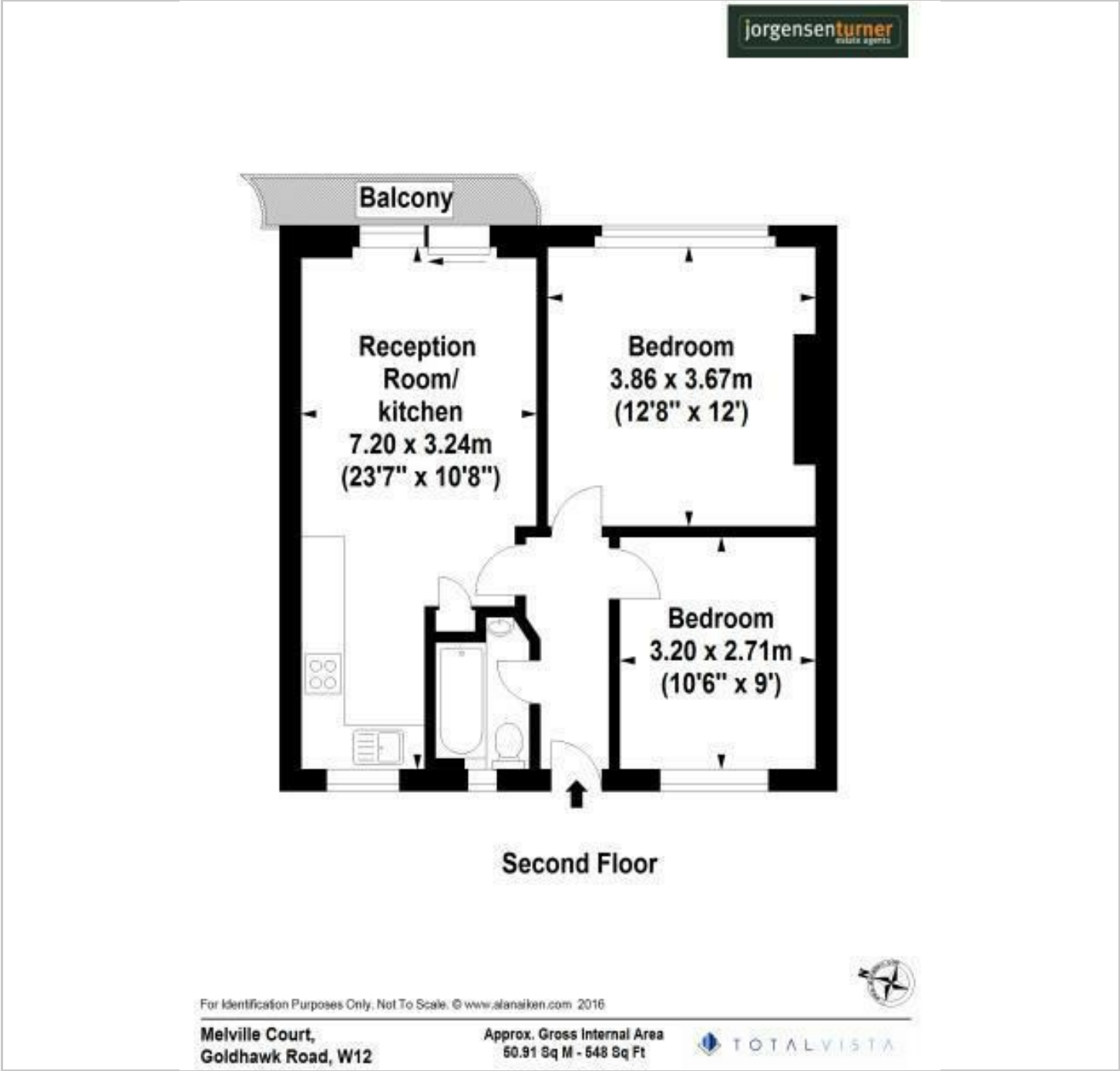

Area Map

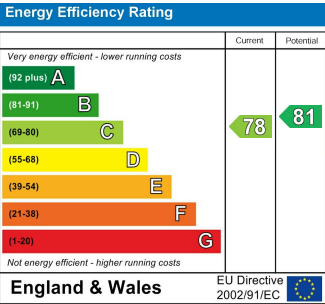




Floor Plan
