The Property

Inside, this well-presented ground-floor apartment offers a bright and practical layout. The sitting room enjoys plenty of natural light through a large glazed door and adjoining window, while the separate kitchen is fitted with modern white units and marbled-effect worktops.

Both bedrooms are generously sized and benefit from built-in wardrobes and fitted shelving. The spacious wet room has been thoughtfully arranged with grab rails and an electric shower, while additional hallway cupboards provide excellent storage.

The property also benefits from direct access to the communal gardens, which are attractively maintained with lawns, flower beds, mature trees, and seating areas.
