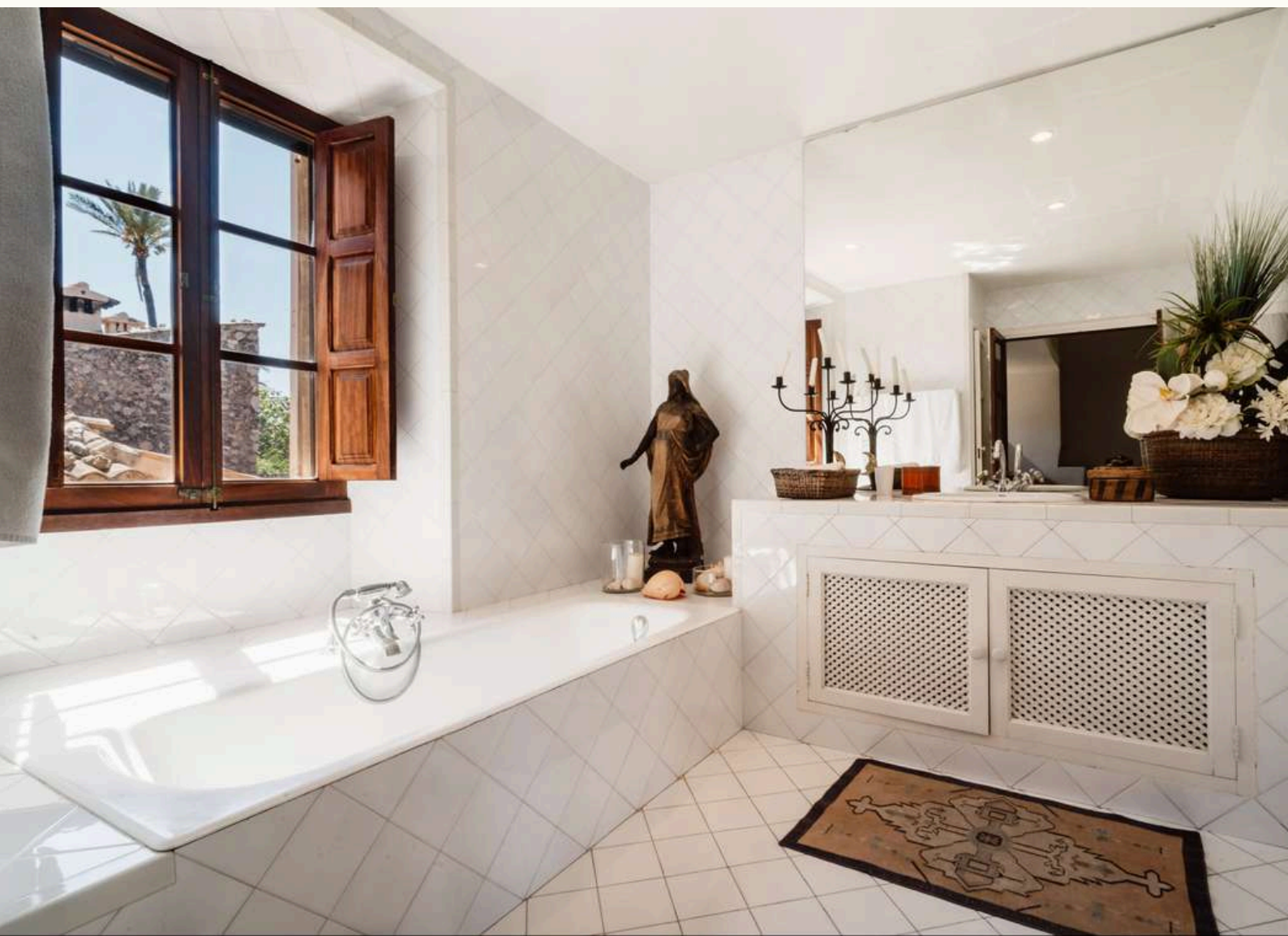

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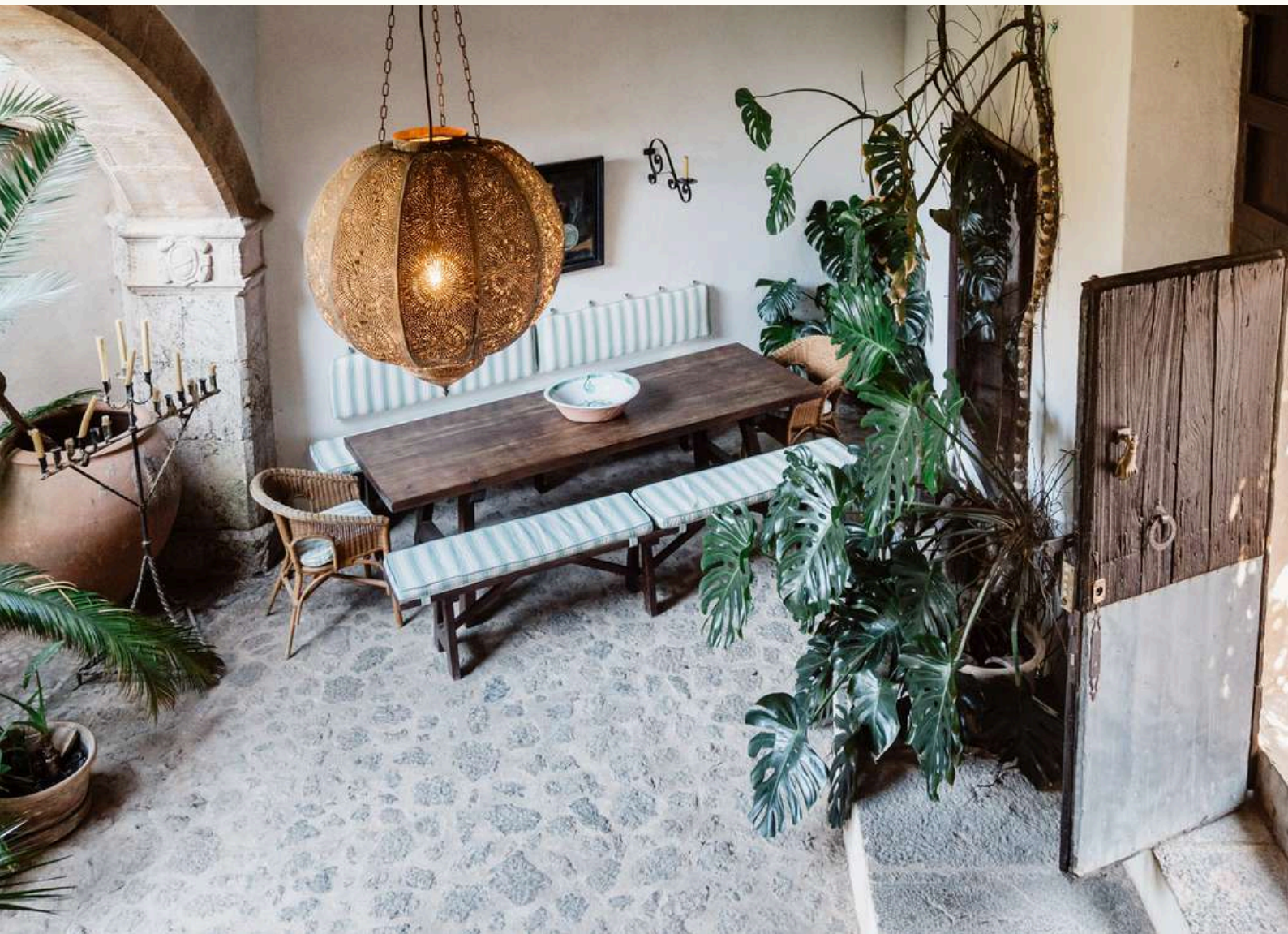


The *Exterior*

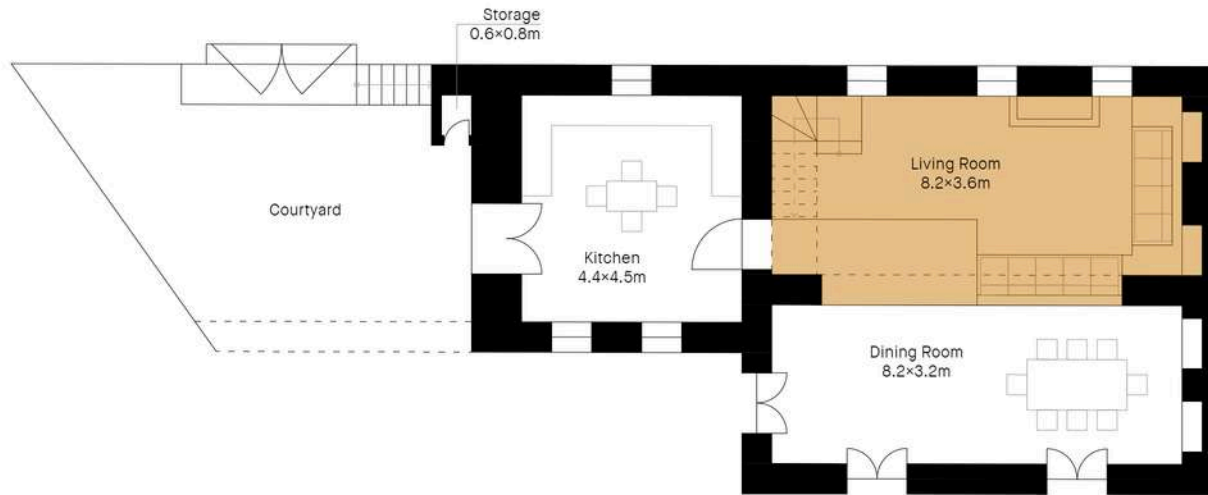

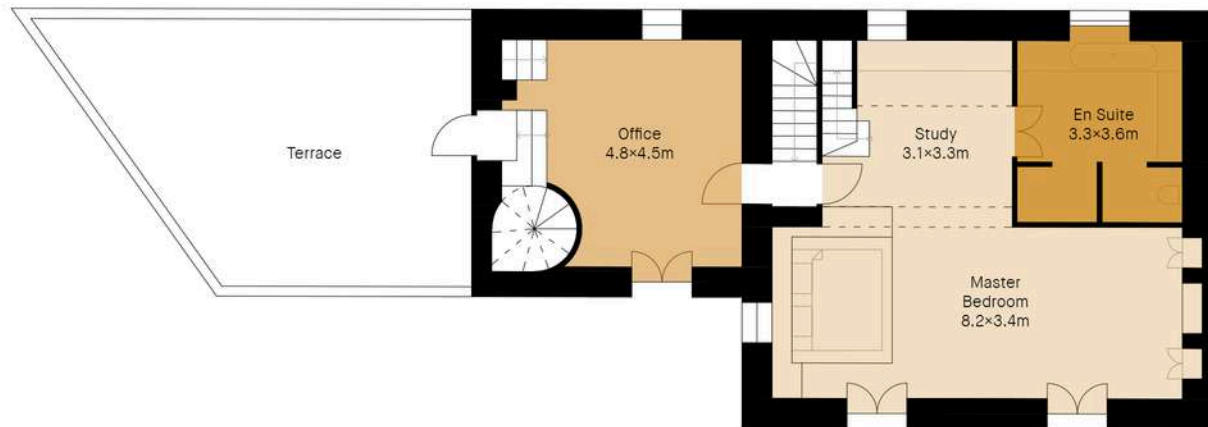


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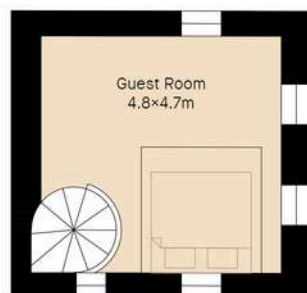
Ground Floor



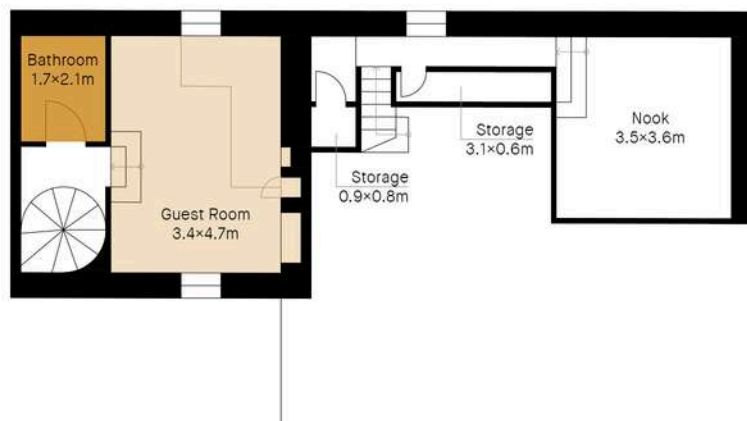
First Floor

Where we feel *at home*

Verbena de Llucalcari – A magical summer gathering under the stars, usually one weekend in August.

Coastal hike to Port de Sóller – A scenic trail with a lunch stop at Patiki along the way.

Nothing beats a boat day – Charter from the port and discover the wild beauty of Mallorca's west coast by sea.



Mallorca *Llucalcari*

Llucalcari may be one of the island's smallest hamlets, but its charm is immense. Home to an international community of filmmakers, artists, musicians and writers, it sits just a 10-minute walk from Deià. Close enough to enjoy the village's vibrancy, yet far enough to offer a rare sense of tranquillity.

For hikers and cyclists, Llucalcari lies on scenic routes leading to Cala Deià and Port de Sóller. In summer, locals and visitors alike wander through olive groves and wild Mediterranean flora down to the hidden cove, where red marine clay is used as a natural mud mask before diving into crystal-clear waters to swim and snorkel.
