# Floor Plan

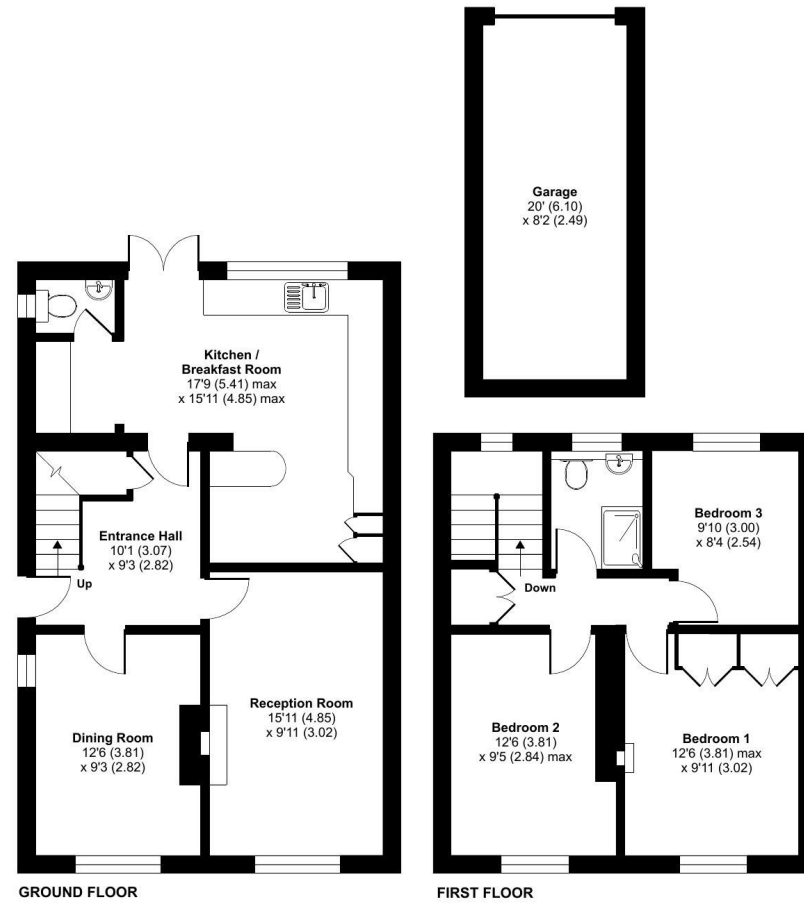
