This welcoming lounge features a semi-open staircase and an attractive stone fireplace with an open fire, creating a charming focal point and a cosy atmosphere.

To the rear is a second spacious reception room which offers excellent flexibility as a sitting or dining room. A large window allows plenty of natural light to fill the room, while a fireplace with a wooden mantle and multi-fuel stove adds further character. The room also benefits from a useful understairs storage cupboard.

Adjoining the rear reception room is a modern fitted kitchen with a striking vaulted ceiling and attractive lighting. The kitchen houses a range of matching wall, base and drawer units with complementary work surfaces, along with a double bowl stainless steel sink unit, integrated oven, gas hob, and overhead extractor fan.

To the first floor is a central landing leading to two bedrooms and a spacious bathroom fitted with a white three-piece suite comprising a low-level WC, pedestal wash basin, and a large walk-in shower. Externally, the property benefits from a forecourt garden to the front and an enclosed rear yard with a large stone-built shed.



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
