The first floor offers three bedrooms and a family bathroom.

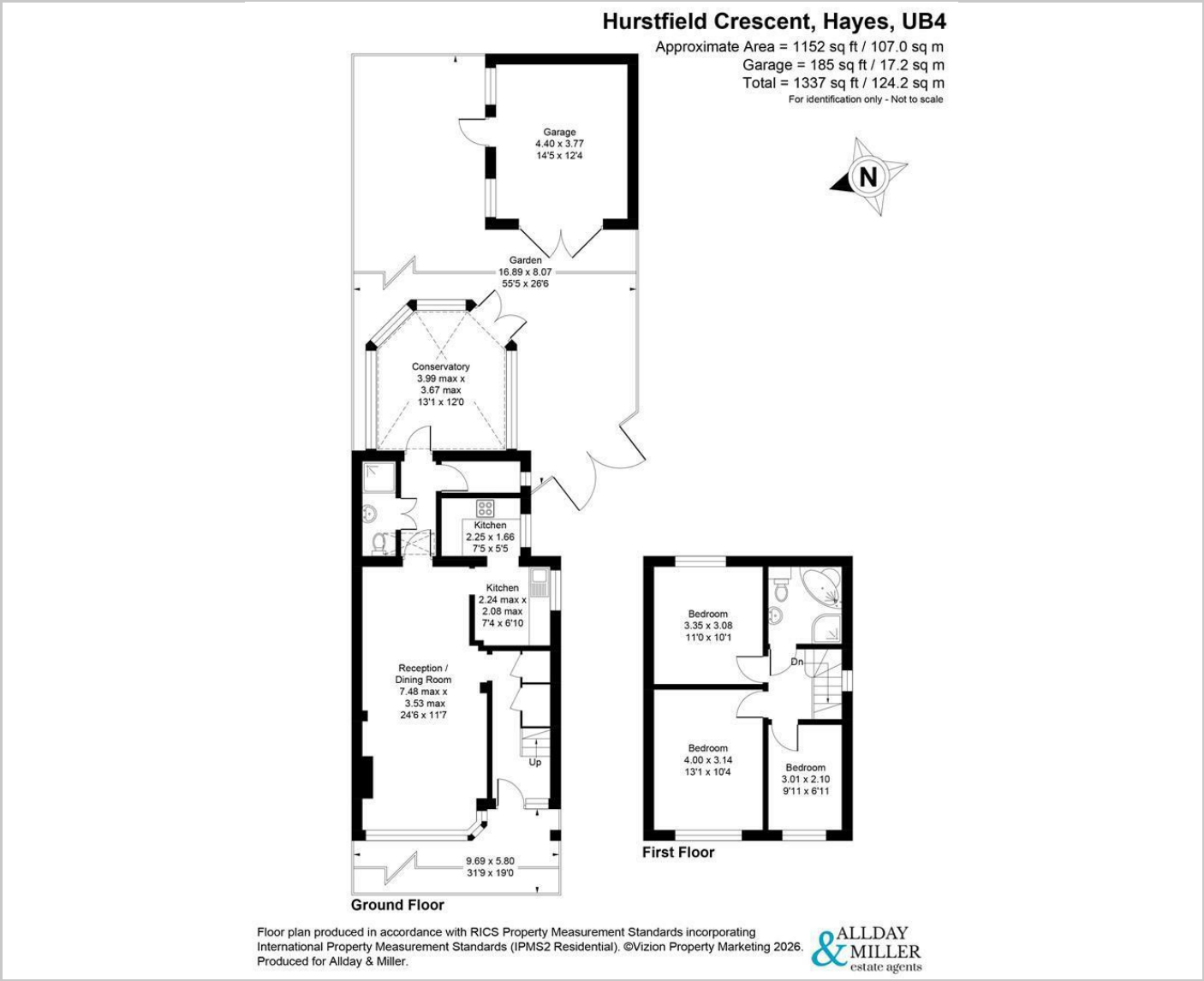
Externally, the property benefits from a front driveway providing off-road parking.

Situation

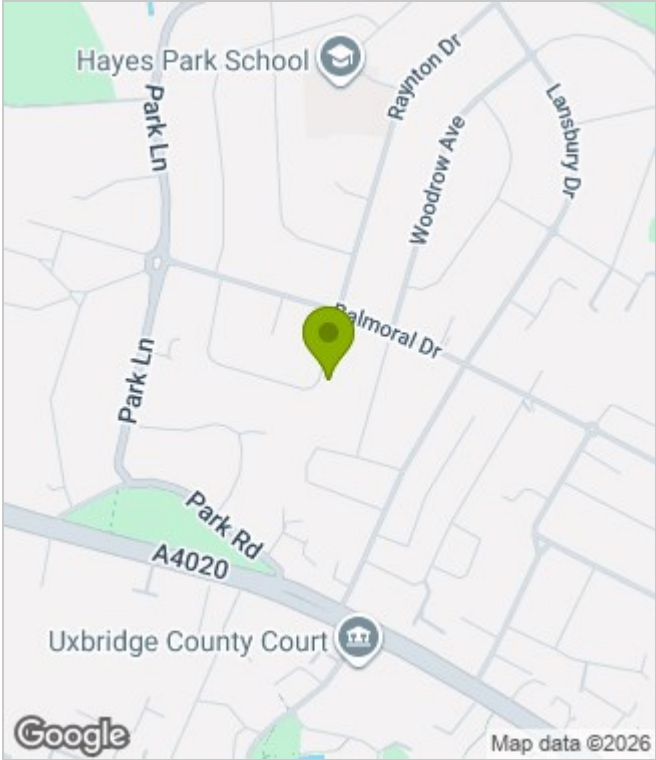

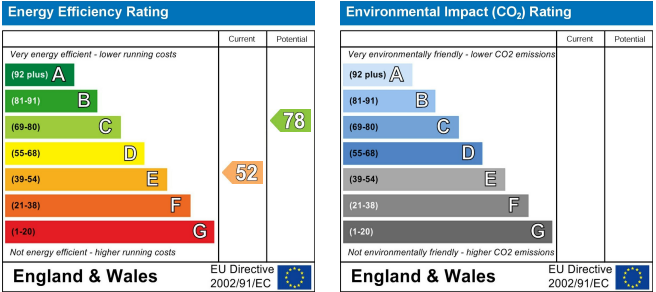
Floor Plans
