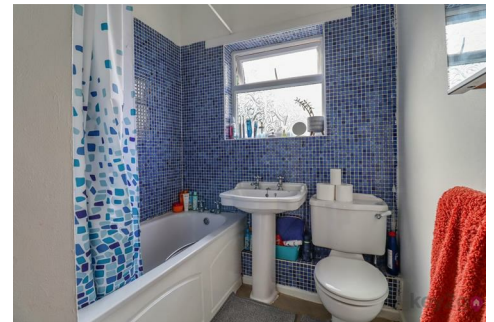

The stairs rise to the first floor landing with doors to a large double bedroom to the front, a single bedroom and bathroom to the rear.

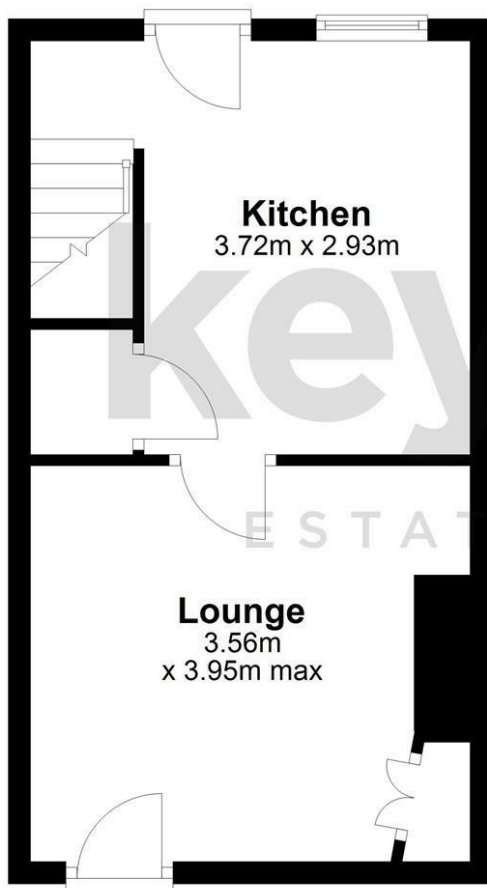
Rear shared access for neighbour and open garden. The property owns a brick-built outhouse with an outside WC, with the outhouse currently being used as an office.

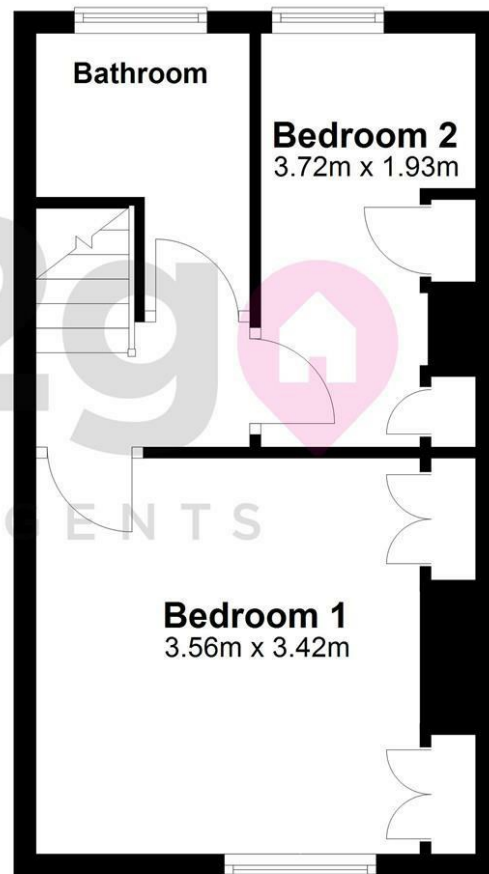
