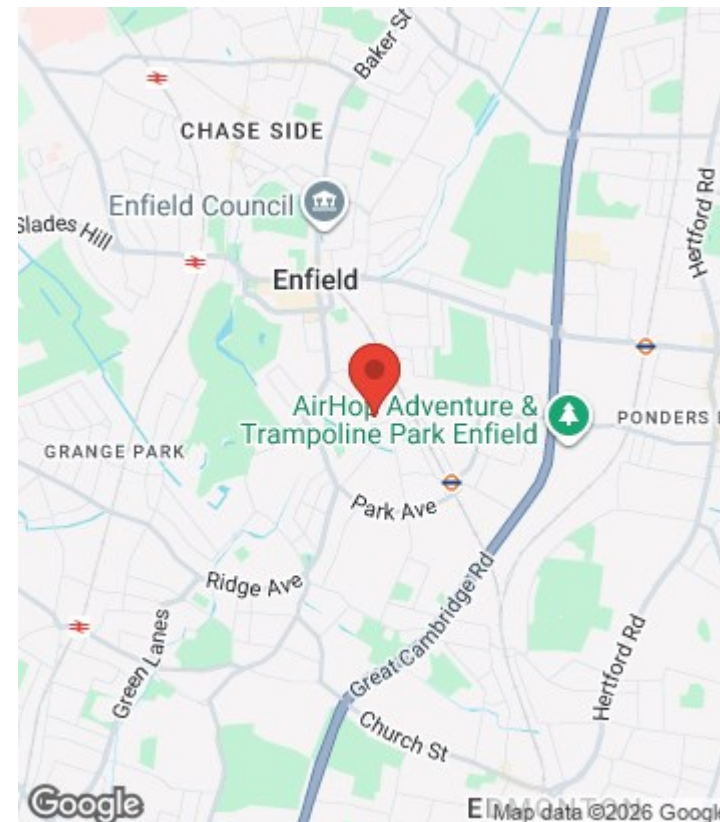
APPROXIMATE GROSS INTERNAL AREA
