The south facing garden provides the perfect place to relax on a warm day with patio area and borders.

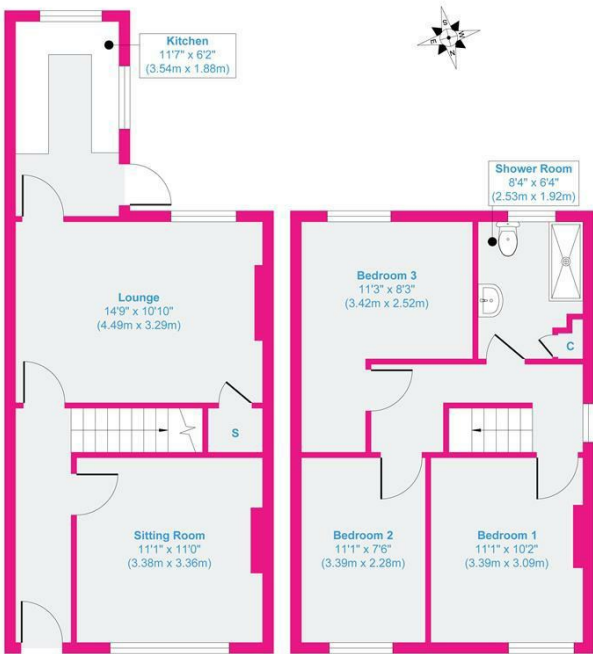

With vacant possession, double glazed throughout and no chain, you will be able to move in at your leisure and begin to enjoy the benefits of this charming property.

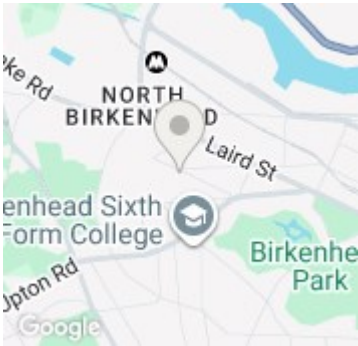
