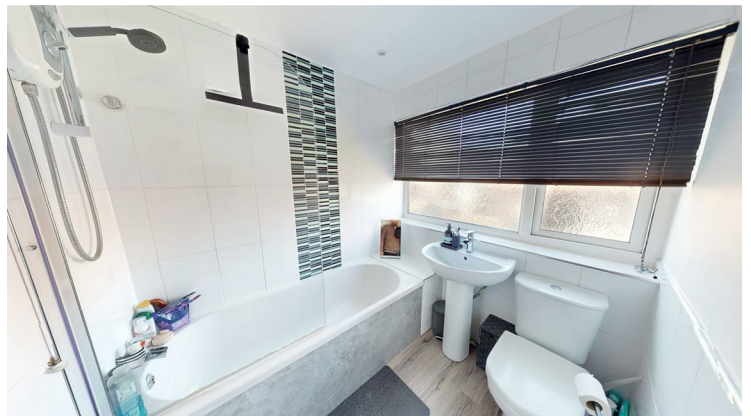
Second bedroom, a further double with a view to the garden.

Third bedroom, a single room with a far-reaching view to the front of the property. Offering ideal use as a home office or a child's bedroom/nursery.

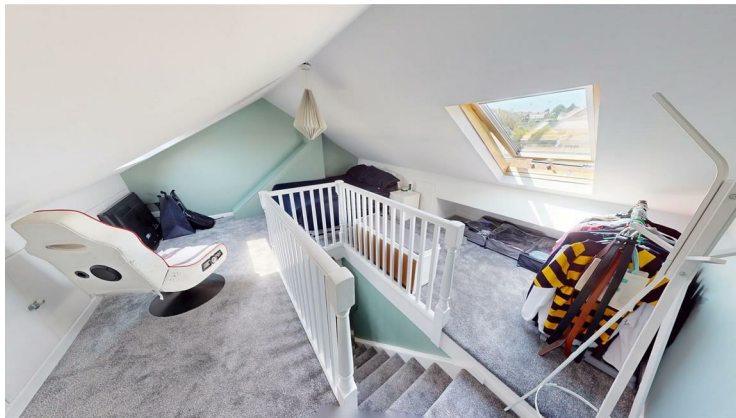
Bathroom
