Set in a peaceful part of this Historic Market Town, down an alley known as Steam Packet Alley is this spacious three bedroom character cottage which offers open plan living on the ground floor and three bedrooms and bathroom to the first floor.

On entering the property you will find a good size comfortable living room with tiled floor, log burning effect electric stove and inset spot lights this room is bright and opens to the kitchen and dining area.

The kitchen is equipped with a good range of fitted wall and base units having complementary work surfaces and brick style tiled splash backs.
