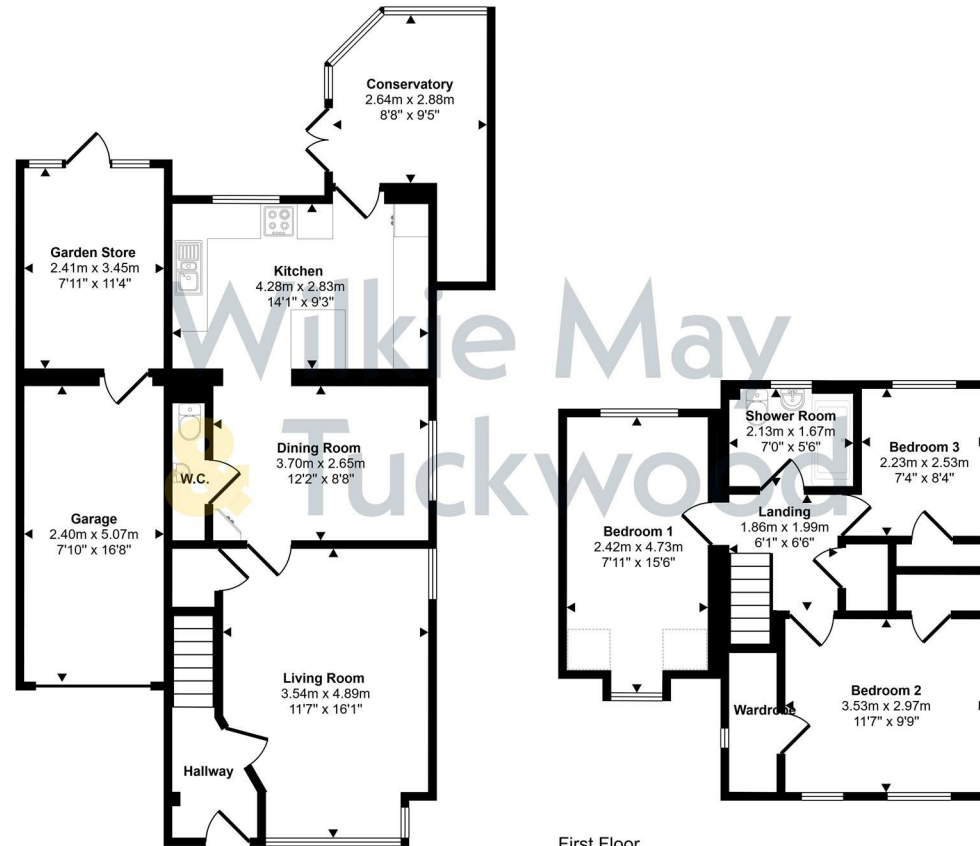

A spacious end of terrace (one of three) family home in need of cosmetic updating, with a Garage, Gardens and off road parking.

The property comprises a spacious end of terrace (one of three) family home built of traditional brick and block construction, under a tiled roof with the benefit of full uPVC double glazing and gas central heating. The house would benefit from cosmetic modernisation, and is situated in a convenient location close to the bowling club, local shops and primary school and is available with No Onward Chain.

The accommodation in brief comprises; uPVC door into Entrance Hall; door into Living Room; with double aspect, gas fire place (disconnected), bay window, under stairs storage cupboard. Dining Room; with aspect to side, door into Downstairs WC; with low level WC, wash basin and tiled splashback. Kitchen; with aspect to rear with a range of the original fitted cupboards and drawers under a rolled edge worktop with inset stainless steel sink and drainer, matching island, space for a gas cooker, space and plumbing for a washing machine, space for tall fridge/freezer, Baxi wall mounted boiler (installed 2025), door into Conservatory; with doors to side storage area, door to garden. Stairs to first floor Landing; airing cupboard with a hot water cylinder with immersion switch, hatch to roof space with loft ladder. Bedroom 1; aspect to front, built in wardrobe, second built in wardrobe with obscure glazed window to side. Bedroom 2; double aspect. Bedroom 3; aspect to rear, built in wardrobe. Shower Room; with white suite comprising low level shower tray with multi panel surround, electric Mira shower over, low level WC, pedestal wash basin.

OUTSIDE: To the front of the house there is a small garden, a block paved driveway leading into the Garage; with up and over door, power and lighting and door to the rear garden. The rear garden is enclosed and laid to lawn with planted borders and includes a greenhouse.

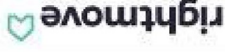
