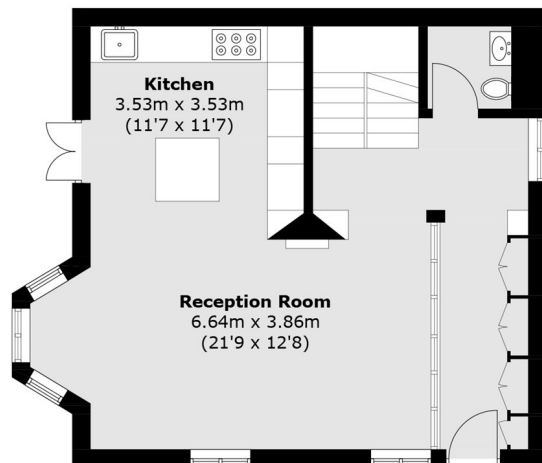
First Floor
