## Rock Avenue London SW14

A rarely available and well-presented Victorian cottage, located down a charming backwater in 'The Royals'. Arranged over three floors, the accommodation comprises a bright open-plan living room and a superb fully fitted kitchen with bi-folding doors opening onto the garden on the ground floor. On the first floor there are two double bedrooms and a family bathroom, with a further double bedroom and en-suite occupying the extended loft. The property retains much of its original charm and character, while also benefitting from a pretty west-facing patio.

Rock Avenue is ideally positioned for the extensive shopping and leisure amenities of the area, including Waitrose, several gastro pubs, restaurants and coffee shops, together with excellent bus routes to Richmond, Putney, Barnes and Hammersmith. Mortlake Station is just a few minutes' walk, offering fast trains to London Waterloo in only 23 minutes and Richmond Park, the largest of the Royal Parks is within easy reach.




