





IF YOU LIVED HERE...

Stepping through the porch, the welcoming reception room sits at the front of the house, where a bay window fills the space with natural light. Tasteful décor and period character create a comfortable setting for everyday life, while to the rear the home opens into an impressive extended kitchen and dining room. Designed with family living in mind, this generous space offers plenty of room for cooking, dining and gathering together, with glazed doors opening directly onto the garden to create an easy connection between inside and out.

The first floor is arranged with three bedrooms and the family bathroom. Two bedrooms sit alongside one another at the front of the house, including a well-proportioned double, while the well-proportioned bedroom at the rear overlooks the garden. The bathroom is positioned alongside, finished in a clean, contemporary style with a full-sized bath and overhead shower.

On the second floor, the loft conversion provides a spacious principal bedroom with useful eaves storage and the added convenience of its own shower room. Whether used as the main

suite, guest accommodation or a private space for older children, it gives the upper floor a calm and independent feel, completing a home that offers flexibility for changing family needs.

WHAT ELSE?

- George Lane is around a 10 minute walk away, with local favourites including Bobo & Wild for coffee, Jones & Sons for relaxed dining and the monthly South Woodford Farmers' Market held on the third Sunday of each month.
- South Woodford Underground Station is within easy reach, providing Central line services to Stratford, Liverpool Street, Oxford Circus and beyond, while nearby shops and supermarkets make everyday errands straightforward.
- Epping Forest is close by for woodland walks, cycling routes and weekend outings, with Elmhurst Gardens and other local green spaces also within walking distance.
