Location:

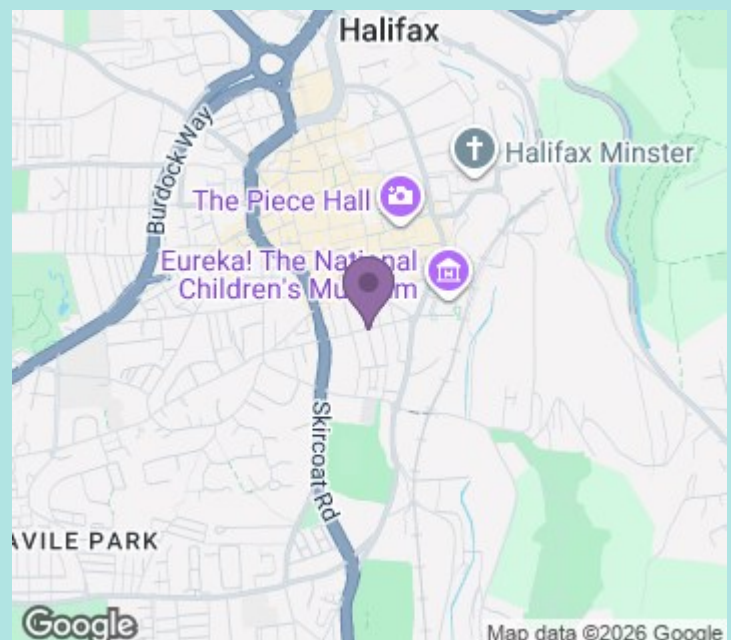
