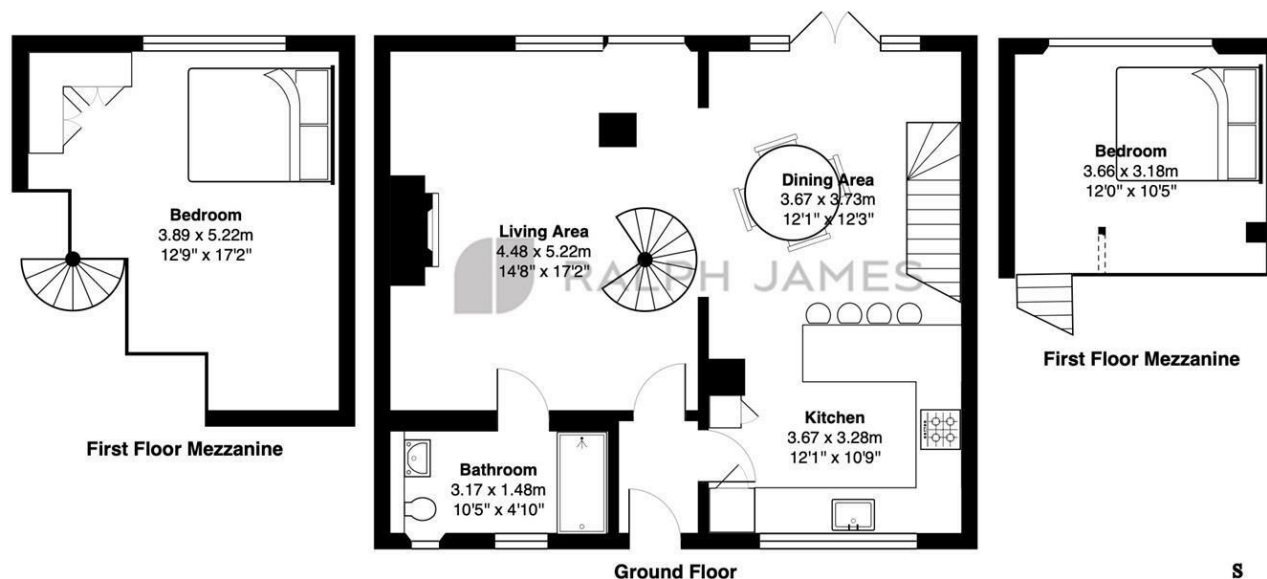
If you've ever dreamed of living somewhere with genuine character — the sort of place friends remember, not just visit — then this may be exactly your kind of property.
