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Summary

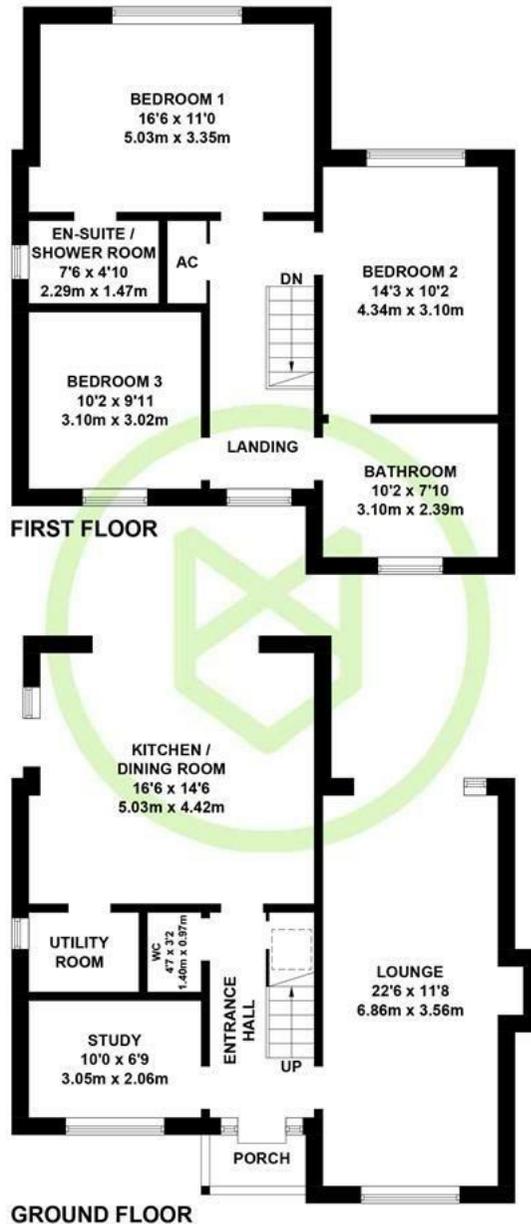

Outside, the property benefits from a private and secluded rear garden backing onto open green space, along with driveway parking for three vehicles.

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Ground Floor

A covered porch opens into a spacious and welcoming entrance hall, providing access to the sitting room, study, cloakroom, and the impressive open-plan kitchen/dining room to the rear, with stairs rising to the first-floor landing. The sitting room is a generously proportioned and beautifully light space, featuring a window to the front, double doors opening onto the rear garden, and a charming log burner with brick surround, creating a striking focal point and a cosy ambience. A separate study offers a versatile space, ideal for home working, a playroom or reading area. Positioned at the rear of the property, the open-plan kitchen/dining room is a superb social and family hub. Thoughtfully designed for both everyday living and entertaining, it features a central island with an integrated hob and extractor above, along with high-quality appliances including a dishwasher, fridge/freezer, wine cooler, and built-in oven/microwave. A comprehensive range of wall and base units provides ample storage, with plenty of room for a dining table and chairs. Bi-fold doors open directly onto the rear garden, effortlessly connecting the inside and outside spaces. A practical utility room offers further storage and houses plumbing for a washing machine. The entire ground floor enjoys the benefit of under floor heating.

First Floor

The expansive first-floor landing seamlessly connects all three generously proportioned double bedrooms, the luxurious family bathroom, and a convenient airing cupboard. The principal suite is a spacious and serene retreat, boasting uninterrupted views across open fields to the rear. This elegant bedroom features a stylish en-suite, beautifully finished with floor-to-ceiling tiling, a sleek walk-in shower, contemporary WC, modern wash basin, and a heated towel rail for added comfort. Bedroom two is another large double, offering flexible accommodation with access to a sophisticated Jack and Jill bathroom. This stunning space is designed to impress, complete with full-height tiles, a freestanding bath, walk-in shower, WC, wash basin, and a heated towel rail. Bedroom three, also a comfortable double, enjoys a pleasant outlook to the front of the property, making it a bright and inviting space.

Outside

To the rear of the property, a generous patio area adjoins the house, ideal for al fresco dining and outdoor entertaining. A retaining brick wall with steps leads up to the main garden, which is predominantly laid to lawn and framed by well-stocked borders filled with mature shrubs, offering year-round interest and colour. The garden enjoys a wonderful sense of privacy, backing onto open green space that provides a tranquil and secluded setting rarely found in such a location. A convenient pedestrian gate offers easy access to the front of the property, combining practicality with thoughtful design.
