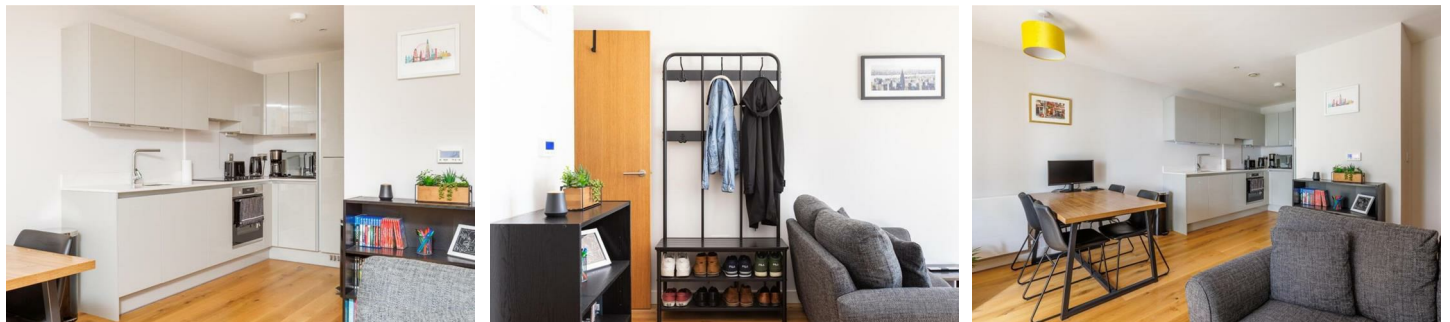

Floor Plan



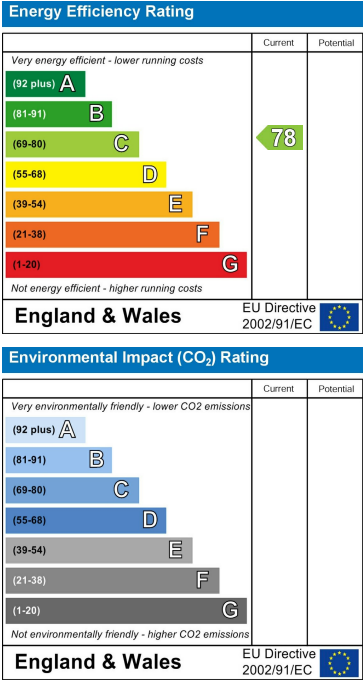
