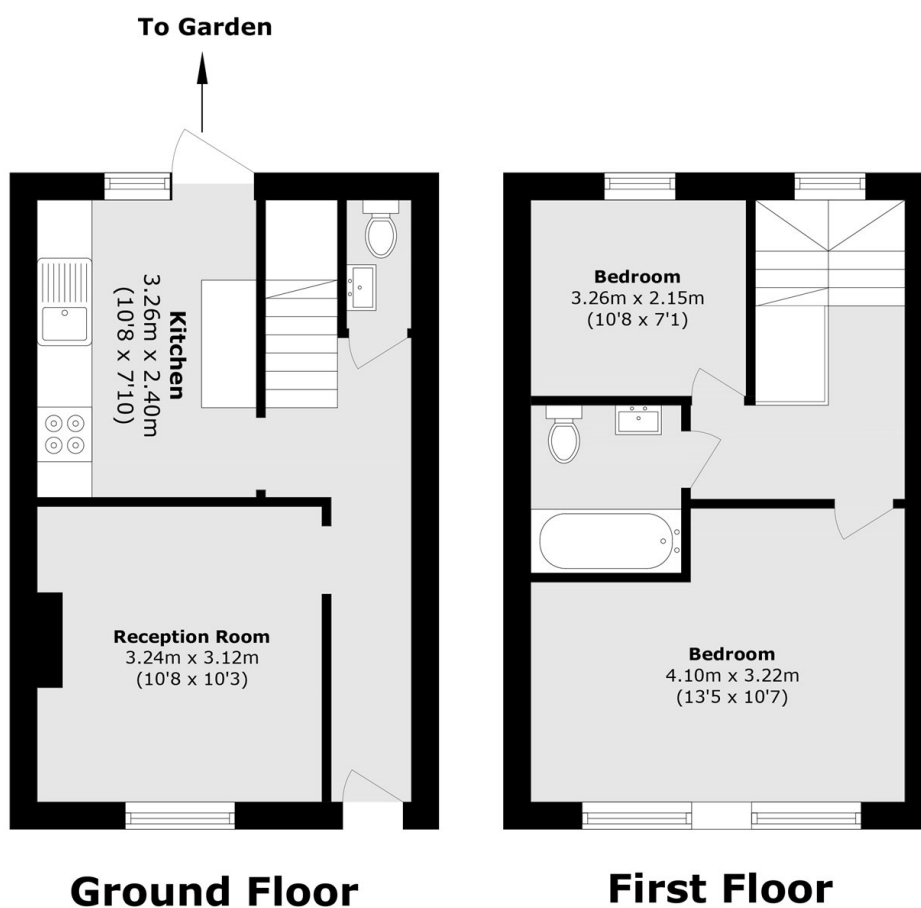
Further benefits include both front and rear gardens, providing valuable outdoor space in this desirable location.
