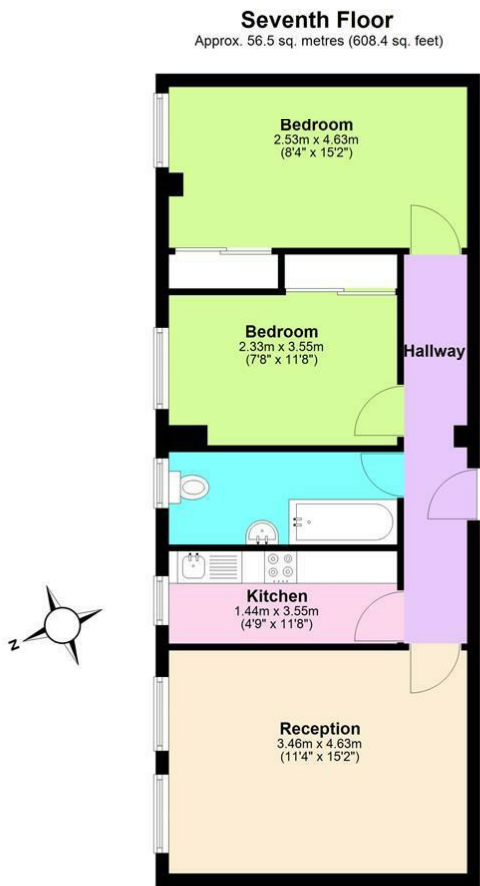
There are well maintained lifts and there is a full concierge service. Heating and hot water are also included within the service charge

Tooting Bec Common and Lido are easily accessible as is Clapham Common.

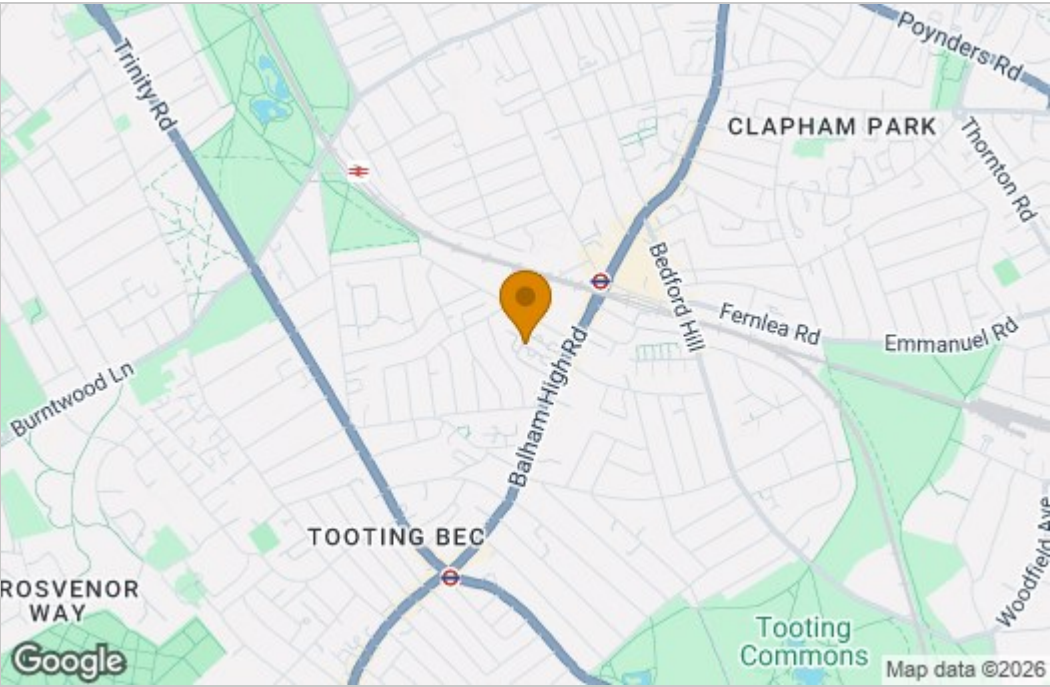
Floor Plan



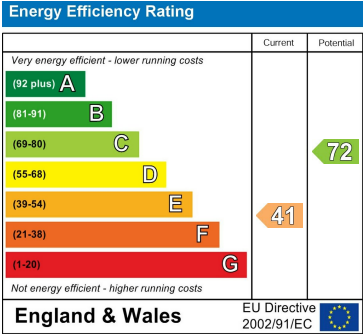
