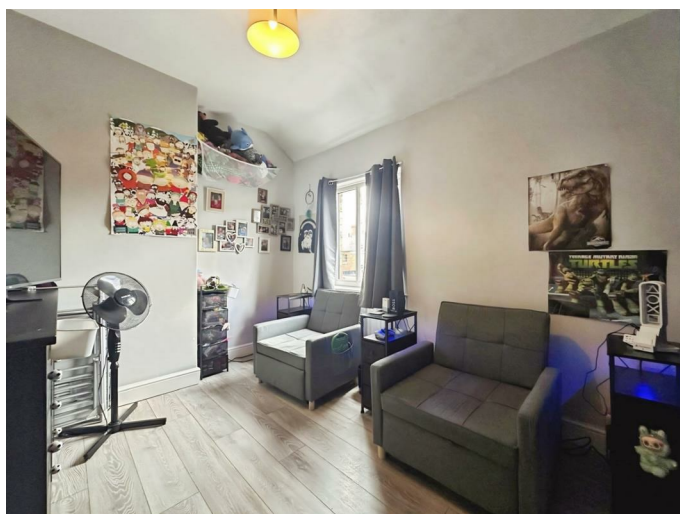

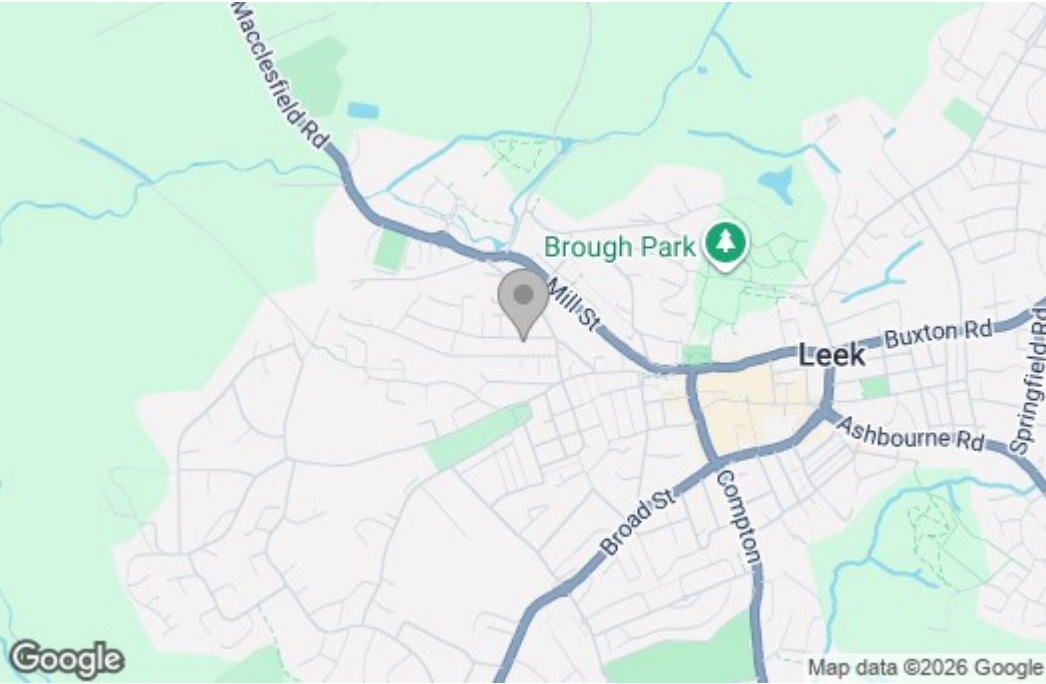

Floor Plan

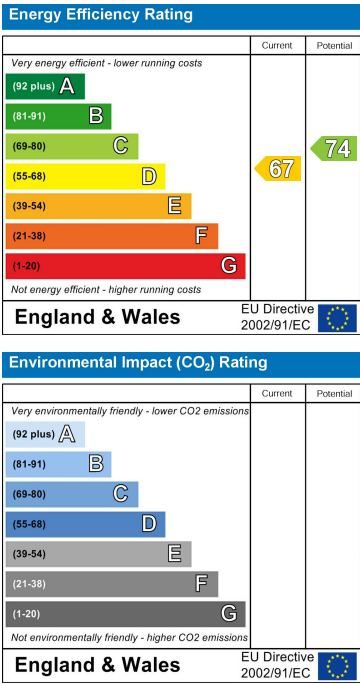
