Dunoon 18.6 miles, Glasgow Airport 54 miles, Glasgow 63 miles, Oban 58 miles.

A prominently sited detached 'A' styled house on an elevated setting with wonderful views over Loch Fyne and set at the end of a quiet residential cul de sac.

Ground Floor:

Outer door with side screen to entrance vestibule, cloaks cupboard with electrical switchgear, entrance reception hallway, under stairs stores, fitted kitchen with space for breakfasting/dining, open plan to sitting room, utility room, bathroom, bedroom 1.

First Floor:

Staircase to first floor upper hallway, access hatch to the attic, bedroom 2, bedroom 3, bedroom 4/impressive first floor sitting room.

Outbuildings:

UPVC lawnmower/garden machinery store, UPVC shed/bicycle store, part larch, part Coraline clad garden room/home office, timber children's playhouse.

Gardens:

Access driveway with vehicle hardstanding, front lawn with ornamental evergreens, flagstone pathway around the house, access ramp at the rear. Retaining wall supports raised gardens with ornamental planters at the rear, mainly to grass with stone and gravel steps leading to the extreme rear, stile provides access to woodlands and stream and walks.

Situation

7 Baycroft is situated in the Loch Fyne side coastal village of Strachur. Strachur is in the sheltered confluence of the highland glens and the sea loch of Loch Fyne. For the most part, the village is formed by the ribbon development that runs along the coast. 7 Baycroft is to the southern side of the village and it enjoys an elevated setting from where there are wonderful sea and landscape aspects across Loch Fyne.

Strachur and Loch Fyne are well known for their natural scenic beauty which has always drawn people to the area to live, holiday and enjoy weekend breaks.

The village has a Post Office and café, a retail service station, an excellent Medical Centre with in-house pharmacy, and a vibrant Community Hall and Sports Pavilion, all of which cater for most everyday needs and requirements. Glasgow is about 61 miles distant and offers a full range of higher and further educational services as well as all the cultural and professional services normally connected with a major city.

There are several restaurants, all with menus that encompass the term “Scotland’s Natural Larder”; these include Loch Fyne Oysters, The Creggans Inn and Inver Restaurant. The George Hotel at Inveraray enjoys an enviable reputation for serving seasonal local produce.

Dunoon is a scenic drive approximately 17 miles away with Glasgow Airport at approximately 53 miles distant via Loch Lomondside and Oban approximately 58 miles.

Primary schooling is available in Strachur, and secondary schooling is available at Dunoon. The nearest independent school is Helensburgh at 35 miles.

The A83 & A82 provide access to central Scotland. Arrochar has a main line rail station with a service to and from Glasgow city centre and a sleeper to London. The frequent western ferry service between McInroy’s Point and Hunters Quay provides travel to Glasgow and the west of mainland Scotland or alternatively Argyll Ferries run from Dunoon to Gourock.

The area offers much in the way of outdoor pursuits including cycle routes, challenging hill climbs, walks and several golf courses. The recently established Cowal Way stretches from Portavadie in the West and travels eastwards for 31 miles through some of the most dramatic and picturesque sea and landscapes in the west coast. The coastline of Cowal Peninsula is fast becoming known as Argyll’s secret coast by Welcome to Scotland.

Sea, river and loch fishing are also available in the area as are a number of commercially run shoots. Some of the local estates allow stalking by arrangement.

For sailors, the sea lochs of the west of Scotland offer safe anchorages as well as spectacular coastal sailing; there are marina and chandlery services at Rhu, Inverkip, Portavadie and Sandbank. Loch Fyne is the deepest sea loch in Europe.



Description

7 Baycroft is a prominently sited detached 'A' style villa from where there are wonderful aspects over Strachur and across Loch Fyne to the mountains and glens adjacent. The house is well presented and the accommodation which is light and bright is laid out over two easily managed levels.

The house is of a quartz stone render finish over an exposed stone or brick base course and the whole is under a tiled roof. Internally there is a neutral palette of decoration with good quality kitchen and bathroom ware. The house is set amid mature gardens which slope up to the rear and back neighbouring woodland. From the uppermost rear part of the gardens the views become panoramic, and it is where a lovely garden room has been created.

Ground Floor

Outer door with side screen to enlarged entrance vestibule with remodelled outer wear stores with coat hooks, cloaks cupboard with electrical switchgear, bevel glass door with matching side screen to broad entrance reception hallway and under stairs stores, bevel glass door to well-appointed remodelled, integrated and fitted kitchen with good space for breakfasting/dining table and chairs, extensive hardwood flooring, bi-fold doors leading to raised deck, perfect for child and pet safety, alfresco dining and sun downers. Open plan to sitting room which is dual aspect and with patio doors leading to gardens. Bevel glass door to utility room with air source heat pump buffer tank, half glazed door to rear gardens, bathroom with airing cupboard opaque glazed window and splashback tiling. Bedroom 1 a dual aspect room.

First Floor

Staircase with painted wood panel detail to the first floor upper hallway, a velux window floods natural light onto lower and upper hallways, access to the attic via hatch with retractable ladder, bedroom 2 with part painted wood panel detail and window to rear, bedroom 3 with window to rear and fitted wardrobe, bedroom 4, or, impressive first floor sitting room, triple aspects provided by 2 front facing gable windows and 2 side facing velux windows, a warming log burner is inset to a fireplace with firebrick slips and a slated hearth, part vaulted ceiling.

Outbuildings

UPVC lawnmower/garden machinery store, UPVC shed/bicycle store, part larch, part Coraline clad, fully insulated garden room/home office, timber children's playhouse.

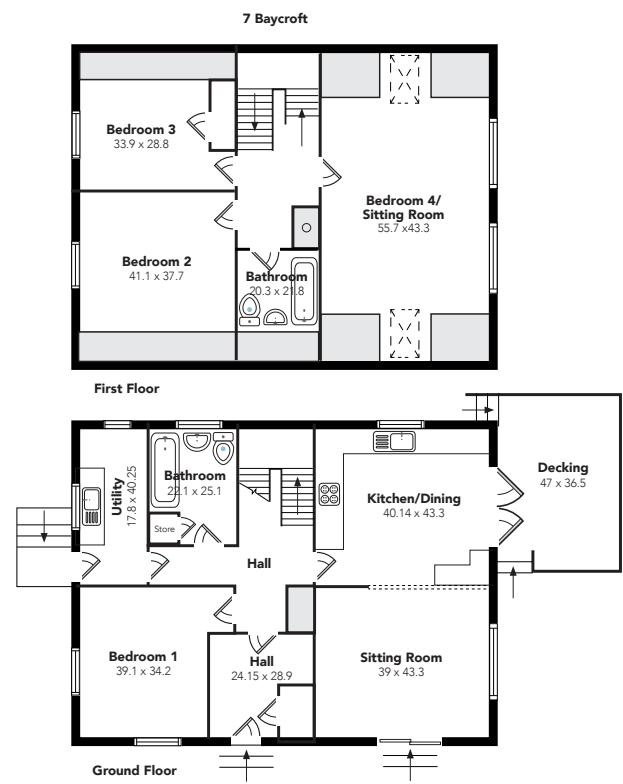
Gardens

Broad access driveway with hardstanding for numerous vehicles, front lawn with ornamental evergreens, flagstone pathway around the house with access ramp at the rear. A block-built brick faced retaining wall supports raised gardens with ornamental planters at the rear which are mainly to grass with stone and gravel steps leading to the extreme rear and where there is a rotary drier, birch and eucalyptus trees. A stile provides access to woodlands and stream and walks at the rear.

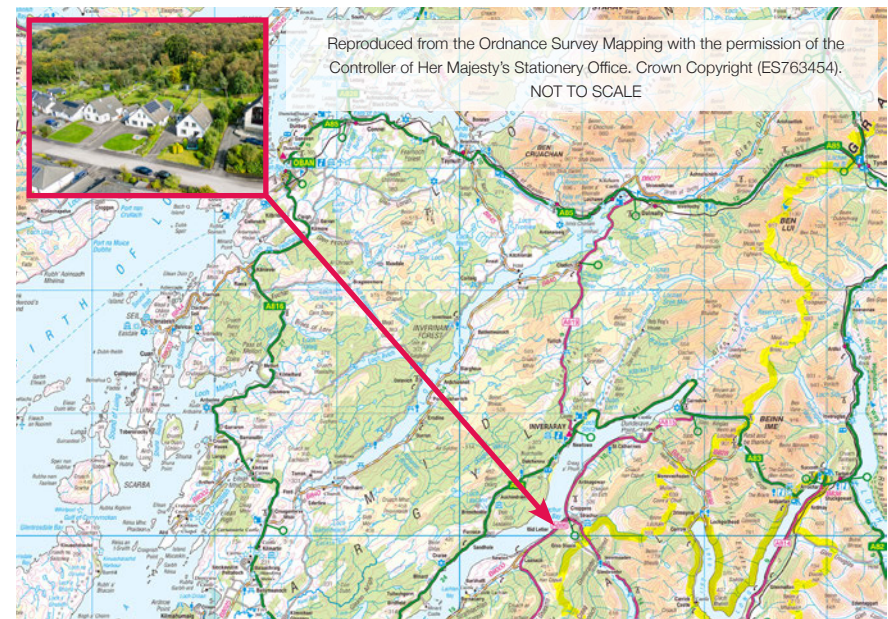

From Glasgow proceed in a westerly direction on the M8 motorway for about 15 miles taking junction 30 onto the Erskine Bridge. Turn left off the bridge on the A82 and continue for about 25 miles to reach Tarbet. Continue to the left at Tarbet onto the A83 and proceed through Arrochar for a further 7 miles. Turn left onto the A815 and travel for about 9 miles to reach Strachur. On arrival in Strachur turn right onto the A886 and continue for 0.3 miles, turn left onto Baycroft. Take the second right and number 7 can be found towards the end of the road on the left hand side.

Special Conditions of Sale

1.
