Step Inside

The main residence has a range of welcoming living spaces including a sitting room with open fireplace, a formal dining room with bay window, and a comfortable breakfast room/snug overlooking the garden. A well-appointed kitchen is supported by a utility room, laundry room and cloakroom, ensuring practicality for modern family life, upstairs provides four well-proportioned bedrooms, bathroom and separate WC.

Adjoining the main home is a substantial two-bedroom annexe arranged over two floors, offering excellent flexibility. With its own private entrance as well as internal connections to the main house, the annexe provides a kitchen/breakfast room, living room, cloakroom, two bedrooms and a bathroom, making it ideal for extended family, guest accommodation or potential income generation.

The property enjoys beautifully established gardens that have been thoughtfully landscaped to provide colour and interest throughout the seasons. Patio areas and lawned sections create ideal spaces for relaxing and outdoor entertaining, while a summer house, greenhouse, potting shed and additional garden stores offer excellent facilities for gardening enthusiasts.

To the front, a substantial shingled driveway provides extensive parking for several vehicles and leads to a timber workshop. A further gated side driveway offers additional secure parking, perfect for cars, caravans or motorhomes.


Altogether, Blenheim House represents a rare opportunity to acquire a versatile and spacious home in a well-connected village setting surrounded by open countryside.
