Offered for sale by auction, this mixed-use leasehold property is conveniently located close to Heaton Park and the Metrolink tram stop.

The property comprises a ground floor commercial unit, currently operating as a burger shop, with a self-contained apartment arranged over two upper floors and accessed via a separate entrance.

The residential accommodation includes a kitchen-diner and three bedrooms, each with its own en-suite bathroom. The apartment is in need of full renovation, offering strong potential to add value.

Due to the layout, the property may be suitable for HMO use, subject to council approval and licensing. Ideal for investors.

This property is for sale by the Modern Method of Auction, meaning the buyer and seller are to Complete within 56 days (the "Reservation Period"). Interested parties personal data will be shared with the Auctioneer (iamsold).
