Two bedrooms, two reception rooms, high ceilings, an east-facing garden, a garage AND no onward chain... Salisbury Road has entered the chat.

If you've been searching for a traditional home with proper room sizes and a few extras up its sleeve, this two-bedroom mid-terrace in Grays could be well worth a closer look.

Behind its fenced frontage, the property starts with a useful entrance porch – somewhere to kick off the shoes, hang up the coats and leave the outside world at the door.

Step inside and one of the first things you'll notice is the height.

With ceilings measuring approximately 8'5", the ground floor has that lovely sense of space that you simply don't get in every home. Add in the traditional arrangement of separate reception rooms and there's a lot here to work with.

A Lounge Made for Lounging

At the front of the house is the separate lounge,

And yes, it's an actual separate lounge.

There's plenty of room for the sofa, television and those cushions nobody is actually allowed to sit on, while keeping the space comfortably removed from the hustle and bustle of the kitchen.

Continue through and you'll arrive at the dining room.

It's a versatile second reception space that can easily adapt to everyday life. Sunday lunch with the family? Absolutely. Dinner with friends? Plenty of room. Laptop open on Monday morning? It can handle that too.

The staircase sits neatly within this part of the house, with storage tucked underneath – ideal for the vacuum cleaner, suitcases, Christmas decorations and the collection of reusable shopping bags every household somehow acquires.

What's Cooking?

Towards the rear you'll find the separate kitchen.

It's a good-sized space with a practical layout and convenient access towards the rear of the property, while a combi boiler takes care of the home's heating and hot water.

The bathroom completes the ground-floor accommodation.

Two Proper Bedrooms Upstairs

Head to the first floor and you'll find two impressively proportioned bedrooms.

The larger bedroom measures approximately 3.32m x 3.60m, while bedroom two is approximately 3.16m x 3.60m.

Translation?

No awkward little box room here.

Both offer genuinely useful dimensions with room for a double bed and accompanying furniture, giving buyers plenty of flexibility whether the second room is needed as a bedroom, guest room or home office.



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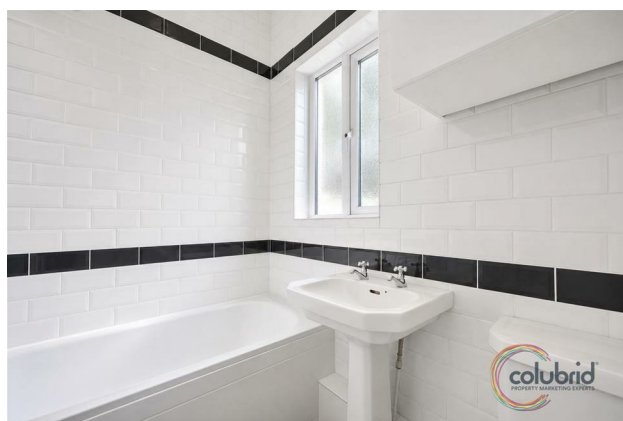

Measurements? Guides only. Floorplans? Handy, but not perfectly to scale. Travelling far? Call first—clarification is free, petrol is not.

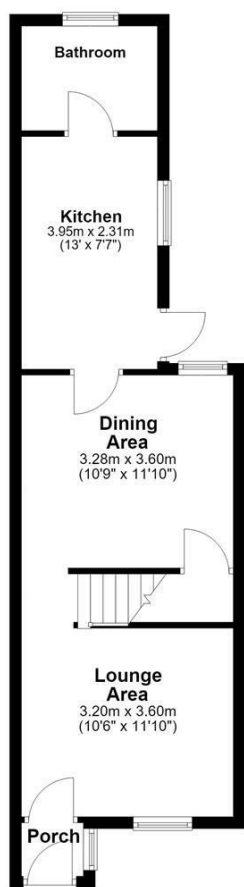
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Ground Floor
