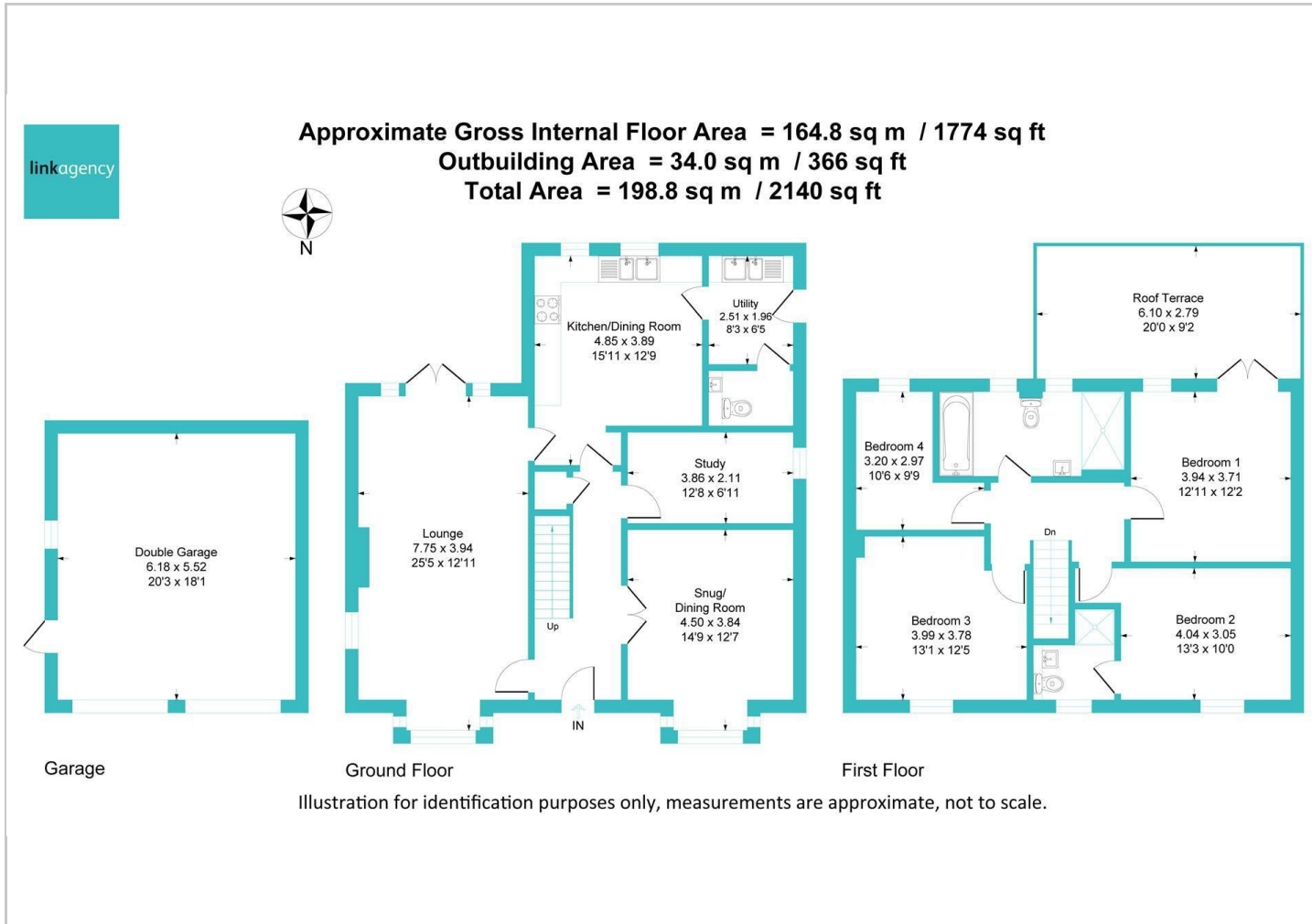

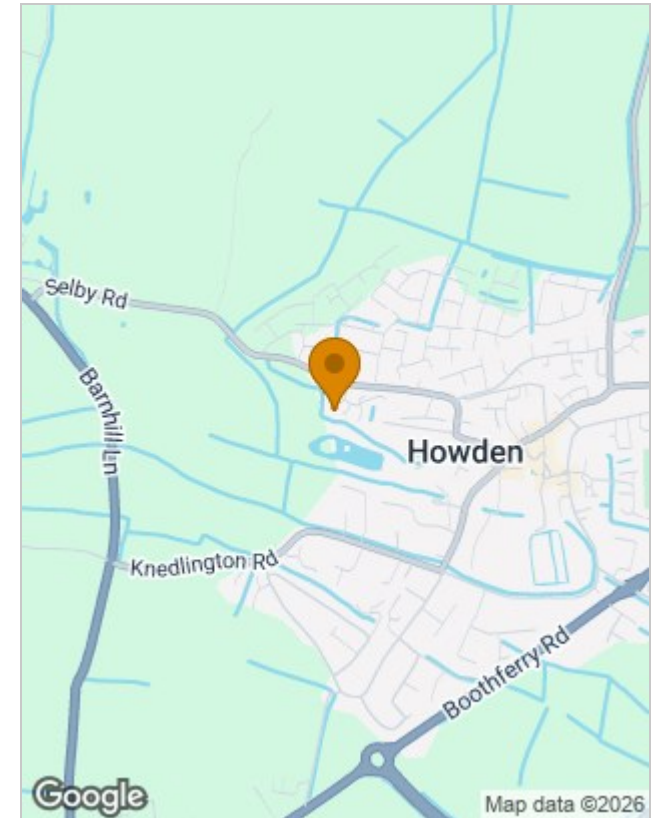




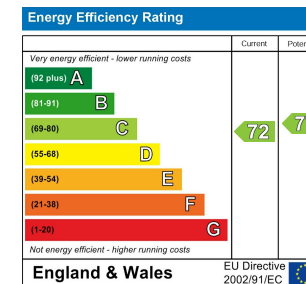
Floor Plans
