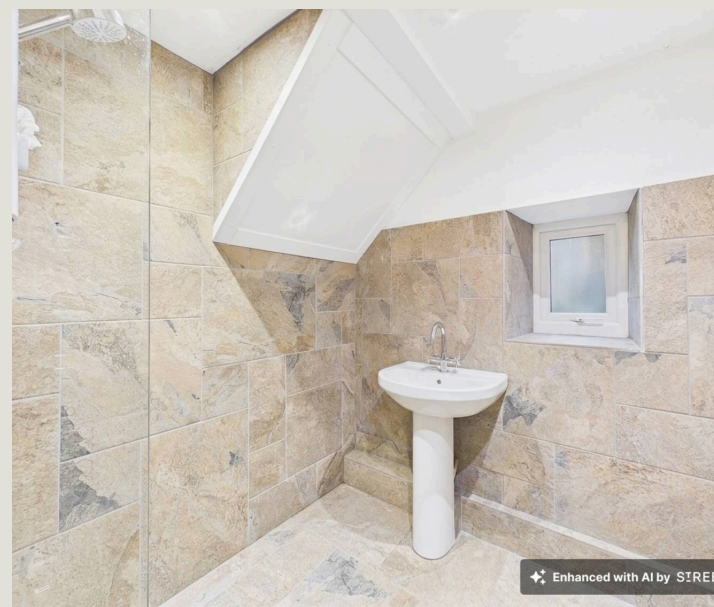

Arranged over four floors, the accommodation is both spacious and versatile, briefly comprising a welcoming lounge, basement kitchen and bathroom, two bedrooms to the first floor, and a further attic room, offering flexibility for a range of uses. The property has also been significantly improved, benefitting from extensive flood resilience works throughout.

FIRST FLOOR

Living Room

Feature fireplace with stone hearth, original stripped floor boards, window to front, understairs storage cupboard and staircase down to:-

BASEMENT LEVEL

The entire basement level is fitted with underfloor heating.

Kitchen/Diner

11' 1" x 14' 5" (3.37m x 4.40m)

Excellent range of newly installed wall and floor units fitted by the current owner, incorporating double ovens, a matching ceramic hob with extractor over, and plumbing for a washing machine beneath the stairs. Oak style worktops with a 1.5 bowl stainless steel sink are inset, along with a glass brick window and an external door leading to a rear shared courtyard area with neighbouring properties. There is space for a six person dining table. Open access leads into a small storage room adjacent to the kitchen.

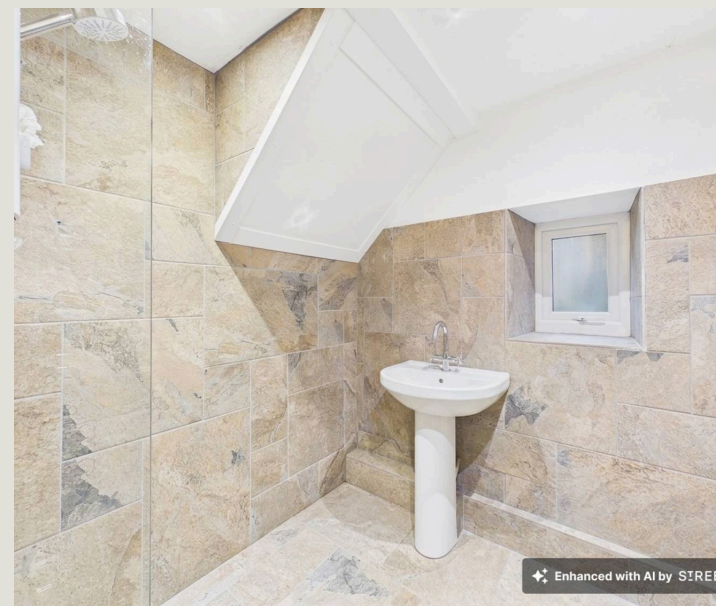
Pantry/Storage

Situated between the kitchen and bathroom, this useful area provides excellent storage space and would be ideal for bikes/equipment or as a pantry style cupboard.

Wet Room

5' 7" x 5' 6" (1.70m x 1.68m)

Installed by the current owner, featuring a frosted window to the rear, with fully tiled walls and floor in a wet room style. The room includes a walk-in open shower, pedestal sink, WC, and a heated towel rail.

Front facing bedroom with understairs storage cupboard.

Attic Room

16' 1" x 11' 7" (4.90m x 3.54m)

Currently used as a further bedroom, this attic room benefits from a Velux window and an additional window to the rear, providing views over the town and towards the church spire.

EXTERNALLY

Yard

A shared communal area is located to the rear of the property, which is primarily used for storage rather than as an outdoor seating or recreational space.

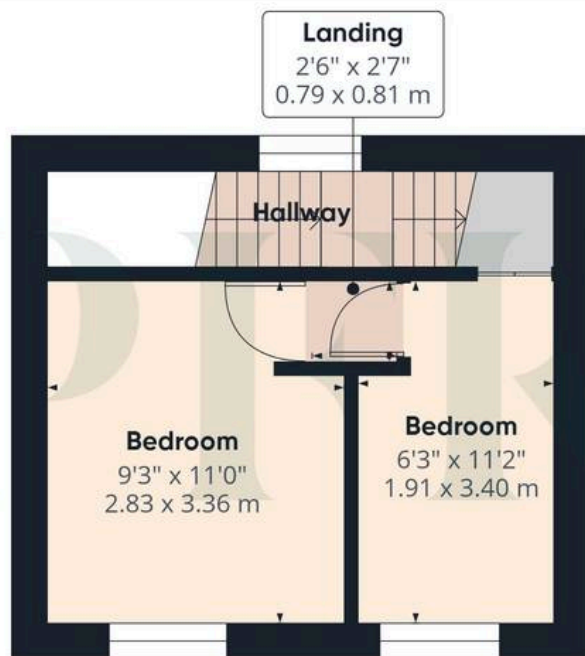




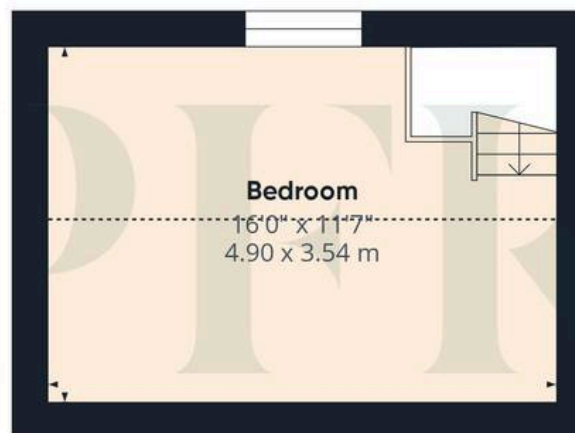
